Forest Products Use and Biodiversity Policy

At Promat, we consider it a fundamental responsibility to source the forest products used in our production processes from sustainable sources and to protect biodiversity. Within this framework:

- We prevent illegal logging and the unlawful trade of forest products. To support this, we source paper and packaging raw materials from FSC-certified sustainable sources.
- We work to prevent violations of traditional rights and human rights in forestry and forest-product activities. We comply with the labour rights and principles defined in the International Labour Organization (ILO) Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work.
- We do not permit the destruction of values in forests or areas of High Conservation Value (HCV).
- We prevent the conversion of natural forest areas into plantations or their use for non-forest purposes.
- We prohibit the use of genetically modified organisms (GMOs) in forestry activities except for research purposes.
- We identify activities in our production and supply chain that may harm biodiversity, assess the associated risks and implement preventive measures.
- We encourage our suppliers to take responsibility for sustainability and environmental protection and regularly audit their compliance.
- We effectively apply the sustainable management of forest resources and the protection of biodiversity throughout all our business processes.

In line with these principles, we are committed to fulfilling our environmental responsibilities and contributing to the protection of forest resources.
